



Linda and John Flakes June 5, 1965 This is a book that includes our 40th through our 49th Anniversary Trips!




Our 40th Wedding Anniversary Trip -June 3 -June 21, 2005


We drove into Yosemite NP where a great mechanic fixed a hose on our Miata. This was a day panic came close but in the end we had a marvelous time!













Sequoia NP is a place where you will see huge trees , green meadows and black bears. It is a place we love visiting.




The drive up the coast was foggy, mysterious and fun. Flowers, scenery and elephant seals dominated our day!




Vision Quest was the most magical place. We heard lions roaring all night and Lisa the elephant brought us breakfast. We loved the Kinachoo!













The drive up the Oregon Coast is beautiful & we enjoyed eating at the Lavender Restaurant at Friday Harbor & Eating on the wharf in Seattle




We spent our last few days in Yellowstone & The Tetons - What a beautiful way to end this wonderful trip!

























A special day rafting in Jackson with Zach, and of course, The Tetons









Our last few days celebrating our anniversary and Zach's 16th birthday were spent going home through the Snowy Mountain Range, Rocky MT NP and Denver.






Left cold & snow to visit Gigi near San Francisco. Drove through a fire area and walked in heavy sand to see Elephant Seals-also went whale watching.





12 for the first time.

































Finished by going to Denver and having dinner at Le Central which has become one of our special places.




This was a special trip mostly because we changed our mind and direction after being snowed on and nearly freezing in the Teton NP.












43rd Anniversary Trip -June

grave of Sacagawea.























We drove into Yellowstone after I had what later was described as a mild heart attack. I took a couple of water pills and was fine.





































Bears are always something we take pictures of and this Mother and cub played and posed for us for over an hour and did not come too close.







What better place to end a wonderful trip than Denver botanical Gardens!
















44th Anniversary Trip - May 27-June,5-2009 Jamie, Shane, Mercedes & Portia came along because no one wanted us to go by ourselves.
































45th Anniversary Trip - Hawaii - May 30 - June 7, 2010







































































































46th Anniversary Trip - May 29 - June 16, 2011




















47th Anniversary Trip - May 25 -June 16, 2012 The Sign Trip

What a trip!
















































































































































































































48th Anniversary Trip June 3 to June 19,2013


























































49TH Anniversary Trip - May 29 to June 22, 2014









