We began this celebration year with a new 2015 Yellow Bumble Bee Camaro!















A bicycle cart tour of the Great Monuments of Our Nation is a memory we always cherish. We had a great driver who shared much information about each monument. This was a most special day!





























Our first venture across Cascades National Park Highway 20 and we were wowed! Fires would break out just after we visited.



First Day in Glacier National Park Look for the moose and her calf taken by Linda from a very long distance





Denver Botanical Gardens - One of our most favorite places - Great place to end this trip!




A blue bonnet trip including a visit to 6 Flags & a Ranger Game was an early trip this year
